



Hands off Rafah now!

Stop the genocide!

Lift the siege on Gaza!

Israel is continuing airstrikes on Rafah, the largest refugee camp in the Gaza Strip. Israel says it will soon launch ground attack. It will be a catastrophic killing spree. Rafah is an area which was declared to be a “safe zone” by Israel.

Rafah is currently home to 1.4 million refugees, more than half of Gaza's population, who are living in conditions of inadequate food, water, and medicine. The area is similar in size to Ulleungdo in South Korea. “We have nowhere else to go,” Gazans are crying out.

By attacking Rafah, Israel is attempting to push its genocidal agenda further in an already devastated Gaza Strip. Israel has been engaged in ethnic cleansing and massacring Palestinians since 1948, when it stole the land.

Over 31,000 Palestinians have been killed in the past five months. 75 percent of them are women

and children. The northern Gaza Strip has been completely cut off from aid for weeks, yet Israel has fired on Palestinians trying to collect flour out of hunger, killing more than 150 people. Israeli attacks have destroyed 85 percent of Gaza's buildings.

The situation is particularly dire for children and women: according to the United Nations, at least 21 children have died of starvation as a result of Israel's blockade. The World Health Organization estimates that one in six children under the age of two in northern Gaza suffers from acute malnutrition.

Women have difficulty obtaining sanitary products, and many pregnant women have lost or are at risk of losing their lives. All but one maternity hospital has been shut down due to Israeli attacks and blockade.

Stop supporting genocide

These acts of genocide have been carried out with massive funding, weapons, diplomatic support from the United States and the Western governments.

Recently, the U.S. government has insulted the people of Gaza by airdropping woefully inadequate aid. It's like bringing a cup of water to a large fire.

The U.S. government says it will build a temporary port in Gaza to receive the aid, which will take 60 days to build. 60 days is the amount of time it took for over 20,000 Palestinians to die in this war.

The truth is, the U.S. government can get desperately needed aid into Gaza at any time. All

it has to do is let in the countless truckloads of aid that Israel is blocking. It is not doing that simple thing to support Israel's genocidal war.

Even if the port is built, it will still be Israel that controls what goes into the port. The plan to build a temporary port is a public relations scam.

Solidarity with Palestinians!

Despite the ongoing barbarism and massacres, the Palestinian resistance to Israeli occupation for the past 76 years will not be easily broken.

Palestinian solidarity actions continue to take place around the world to protest Israel's genocide and the complicity of the US and the West. In South Korea, hundreds of Palestinians and Koreans have been rallying and marching every week, not only in Seoul, but also in Incheon, Busan, Suwon, Ulsan, and other places.
